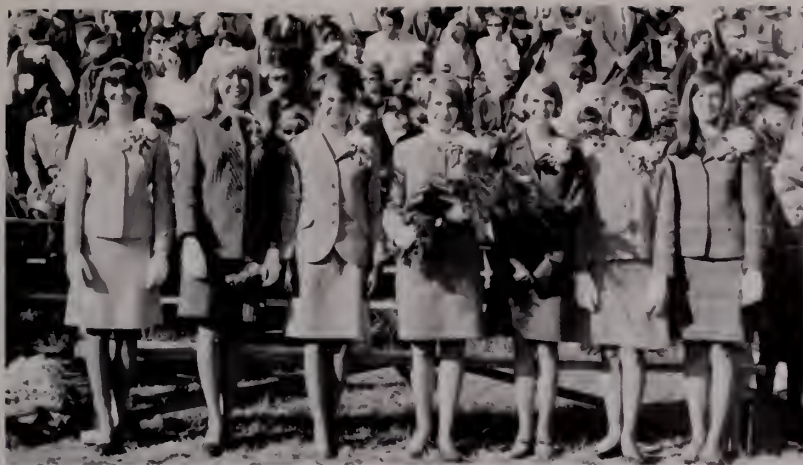

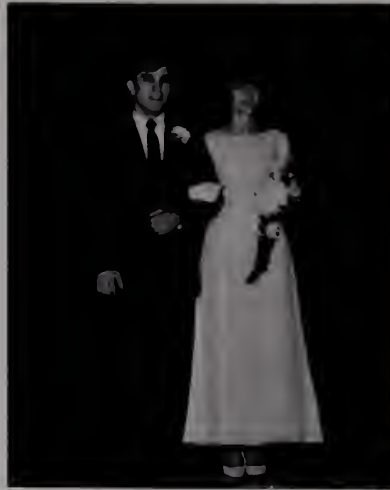

CHARLES E. SPEARS, *Superintendent*

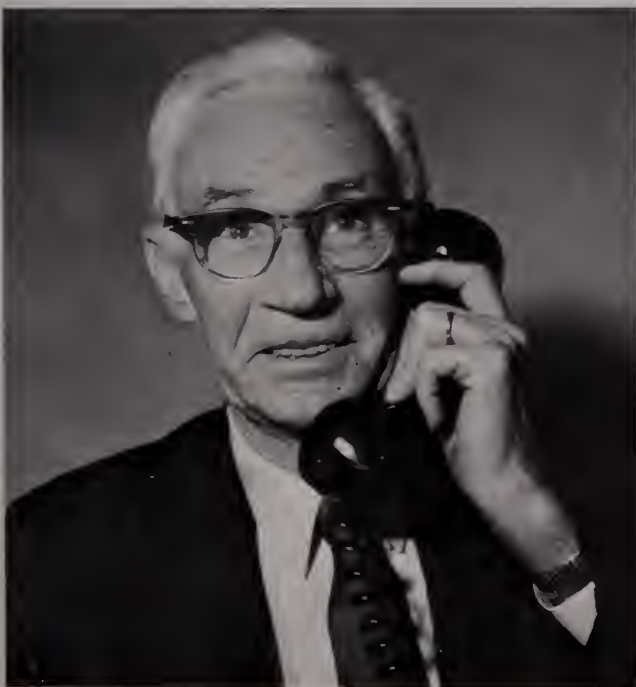

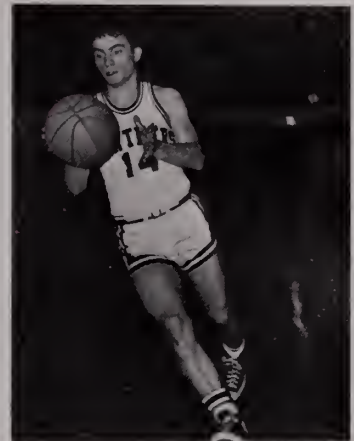
