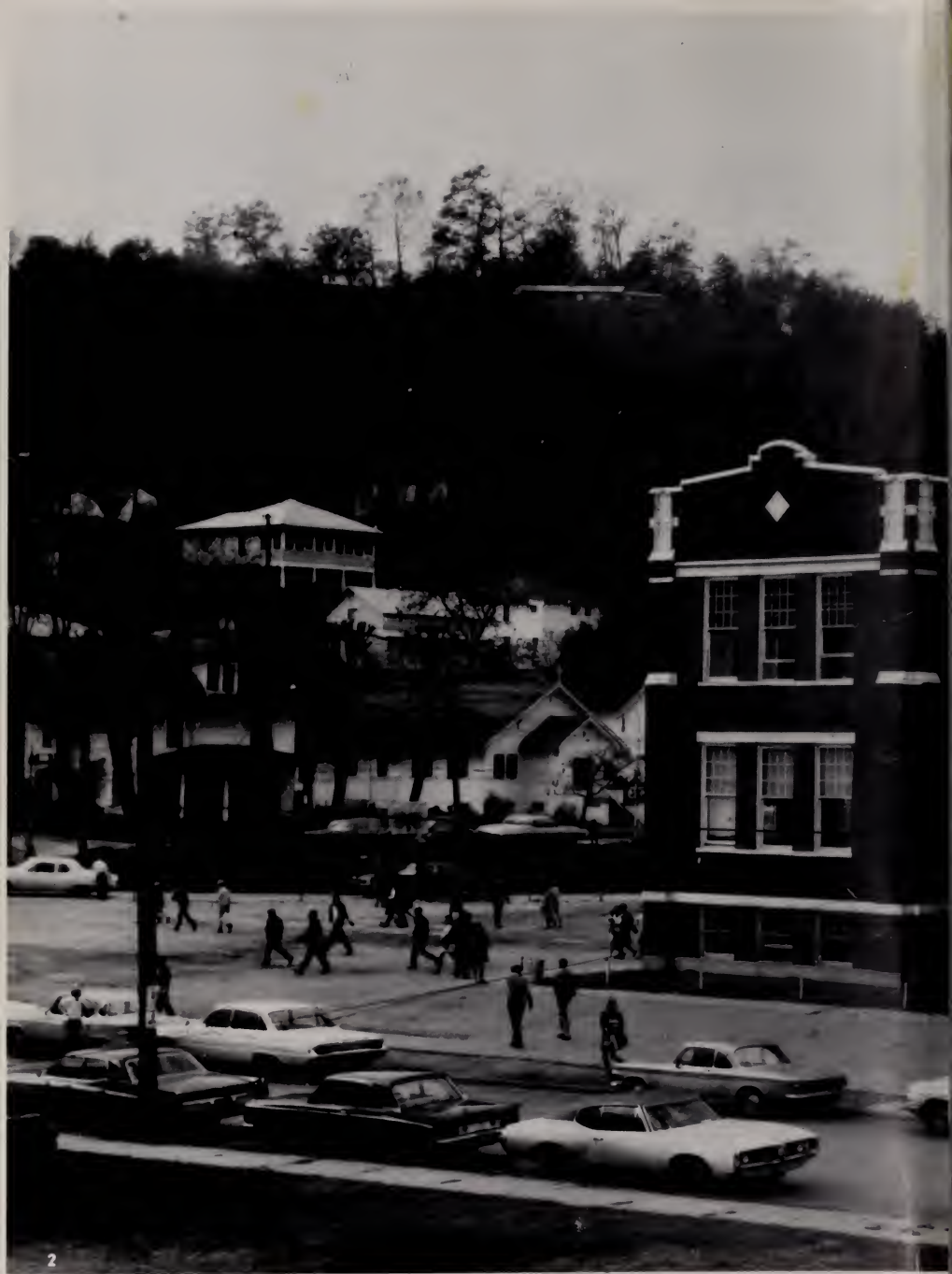

The T. W. Oliver Memorial Gymnasium was destroyed by fire of an unknown origin Tuesday, July 31, 1969. The gym had been the symbol of school spirit for students and alumni of Pikeville High School for twenty years. Tears came to the eyes of many as they saw this building destroyed beyond repair leaving behind the rubble of scorched and blackened brick and stone and broken twisted trophies. We soon came to realize it was not the building itself we loved but the memories the gym had held. Dedicated on December 9, 1949, this building was the center of many activities over the area for two decades. It was the gym we entered for home ballgames and district tournaments with all their intense moments of jubilant victory and agonizing defeat. It was here many boys and girls began their days of courtship with attendance at sockhops, twist parties, Homecoming dances, and Proms when the gym became a beautifully decorated room. The halls of the gym echoed for many years with the resounding thuds, groans, and yells of P.E. classes exercising, or athletes practicing. It was here the seniors said their farewell to high school with tears and laughter at graduation. Our gym has served us well and our community well. The doors were always open for civic meetings, special events, concerts and recreation.

Now all that remains of the gymnasium is an empty space covered with crushed red brick and used as a parking lot. But our memories remain and we look forward to the future to a new gym where new teams will win and others will dance or say farewell.

The band had a car wash, a tag day, sold cards, and did various other things. The PHS band will as a result be dressed in beautiful maroon uniforms next year, and hold their heads high as they proudly march by. They have a lot to be proud of, and we're happy to have them represent Pikeville High.

Those who watched the gym burn on July 31, 1969, sadly watched as the three rooms on the edge of the building burned with a brighter flame. These rooms were the band rooms, and the brighter flame was due to the burning of thousands of pieces of music and valuable instruments, and trophies. Standing on the railroad track and watching this pitiful sight made one wonder what the PHS Band would do for the coming year. No copies of the beloved school song or even "The Star Spangled Banner!" At any rate, the band, under the able direction of Mr. C. J. Birch, soon got back into the swing of things. They borrowed music and instruments from various places and headed out to Camp Crescendo for a week of intensive training in marching and music. In all there were 65 band members, 4 majorettes, and one drum major. These people, along with Mr. Birch, made up the framework that was necessary in the rebuilding of our band. The school board funded money for the purchase of new instruments and music, and the band parents began to raise money. The school provided two rooms to be used as band rooms, and the band set to work. They were always on hand for pep rallies, football games, basketball games, and parades. Due to the generosity of the student body, the band had a banner to proudly announce their hometown. They attended a marching band contest in Ashland, and the majorettes received second place honors at camp and the Regional Majorette Contest and third place honors at Ashland. The community began to recognize the band as a hard-working organization. Their work and able ability showed through as they received three superior ratings at contest in the spring. Due to the fact that thirty new members would enter the band next year, it became obvious that new uniforms would be needed. The band parents set to work, selling tickets on radios, car tape players, boats, etc.
