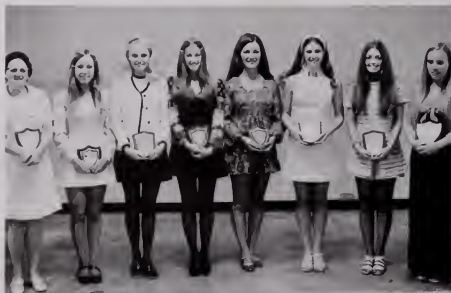

## Career Education

The Pikeville Exemplary Education Project completed its second year of work when school closed in June 1972. A cooperative effort between the Pikeville Independent School District and Eastern Kentucky University, the three year exemplary education program has established the following objectives: (1) establish a curriculum in which occupational orientation and occupational training is offered grades 1 through 12; (2) provide guidance and educational opportunities for all students in all grades to establish positive relationships between school and world of work; and (3) provide expanded vocational, work study and cooperative vocational programs for all students regardless of their level of matriculation. During the third year, 1972-73, the program will focus on the senior high school. Included in the plans are career education instruction in all academic subjects, and articulated guidance programs in grades 1 through 12, and expanded opportunities in agriculture and health services.

Pikeville City Schools feel very fortunate in having this exemplary program and in having such a fine staff to work with.
