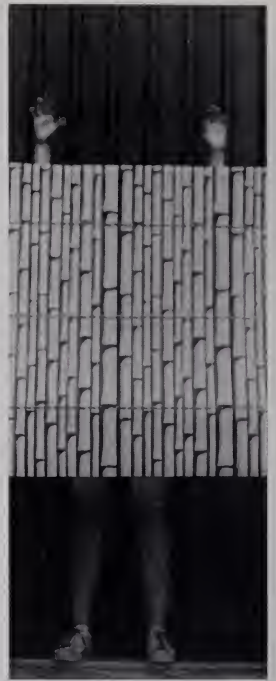

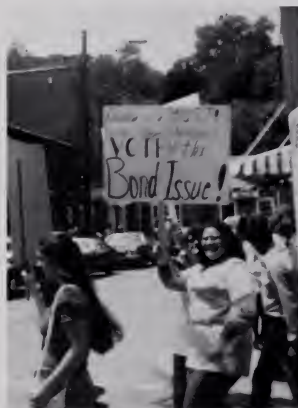

On May 29, 1973 the citizens of Pikeville took a major step toward the goal of a new high school by passing a bond issue which will finance the construction of the 2.9 million dollar facility.

The structure will be located on a four and one-half acre site North of Pikeville adjacent to the 11½ acre athletic field. The facility will include a gym which will seat 3,000 spectators, a commons area with kitchen which will also serve as a student lounge and meeting area, an elevated lecture hall with seating capacity of 125, band room with private rehearsal rooms, plus science labs, Industrial Arts, and other class rooms to accommodate all academic areas.

We at Pikeville High School and Pikeville Elementary School are looking forward with pride to the Fall of 1975 when we enter a new facility and a new day in education for the youth of Pikeville.

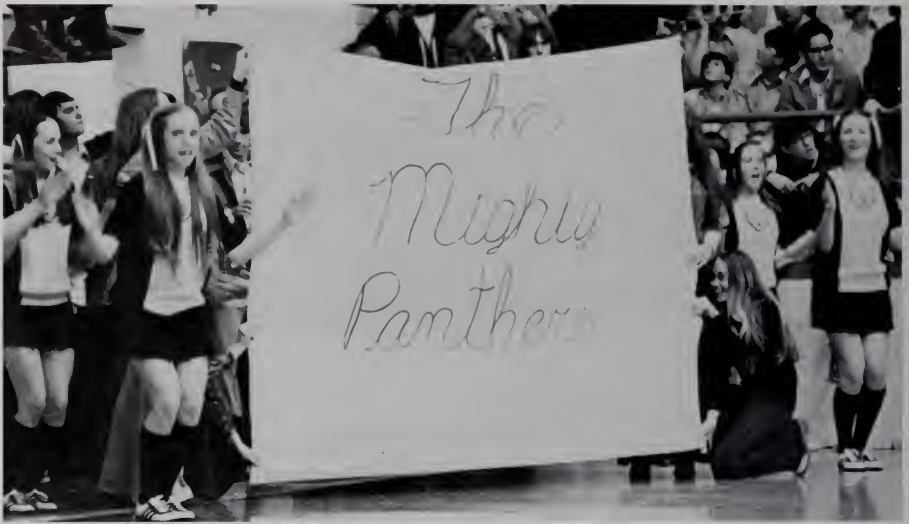

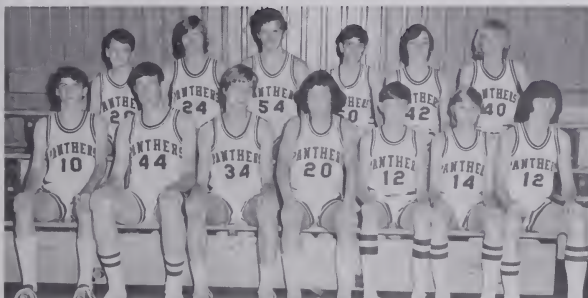
