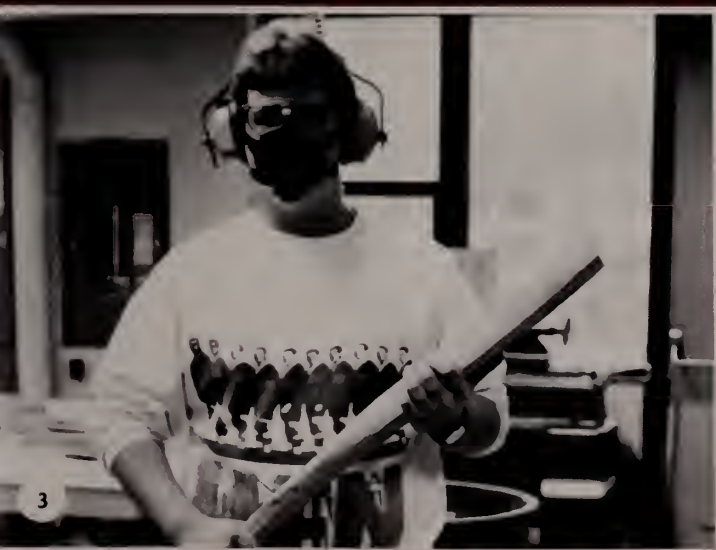
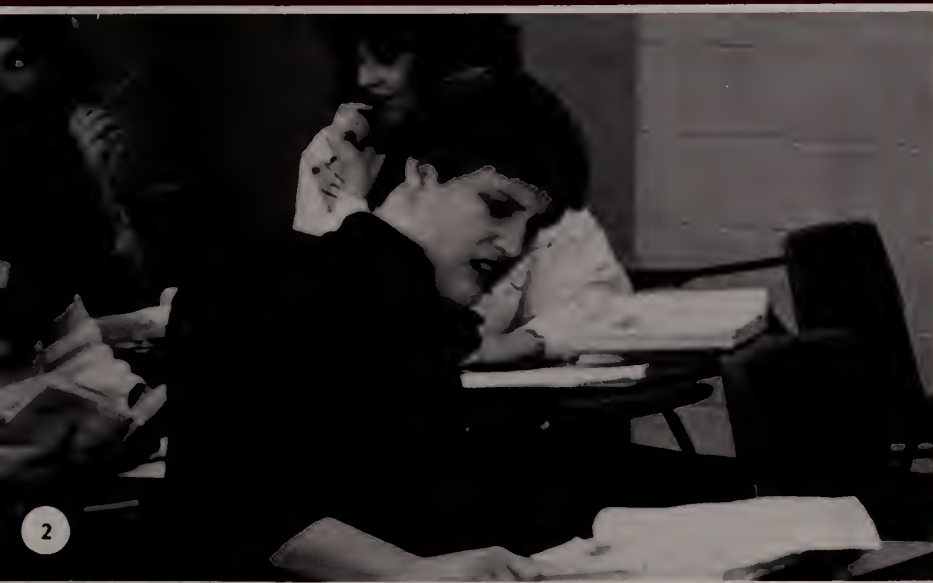
# "MORNINGS OF OUR LIVES"

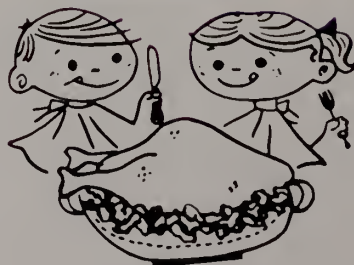


(1) Lisa Altman is apparently experiencing the all too familiar "morning brain drain."

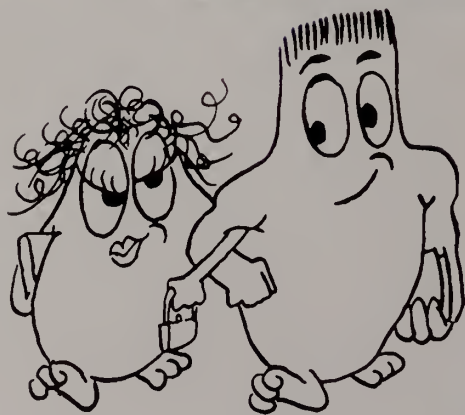
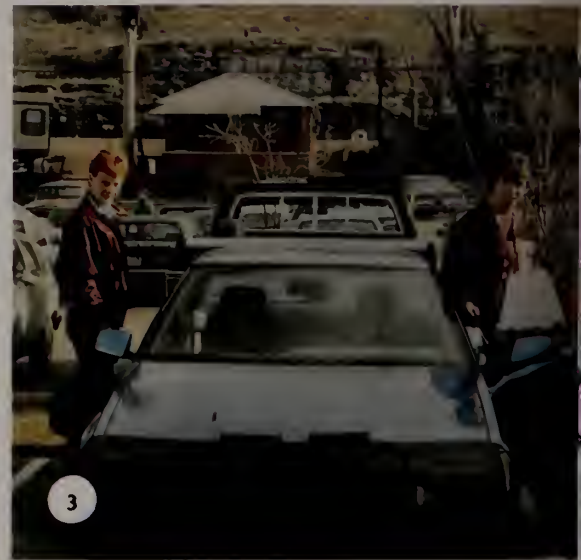


# "LOVE IN THE AFTERNOON"

# HOMECOMING — 1985

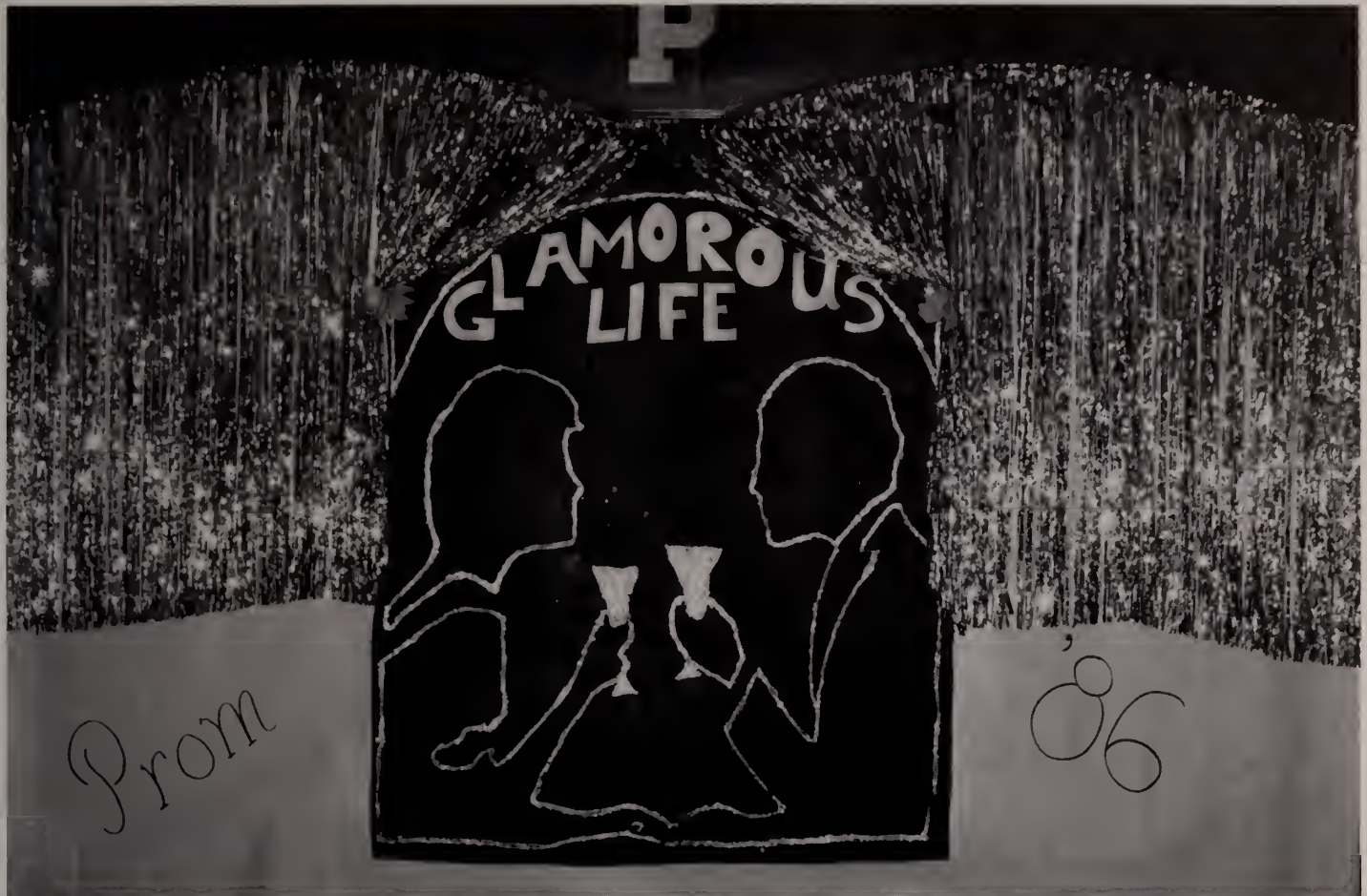
