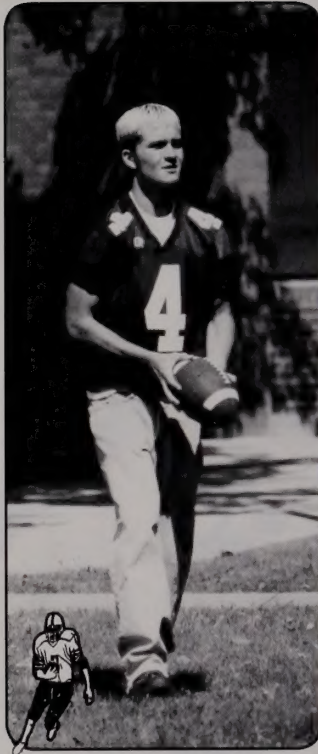




WELCOME TO THE "VILLE"

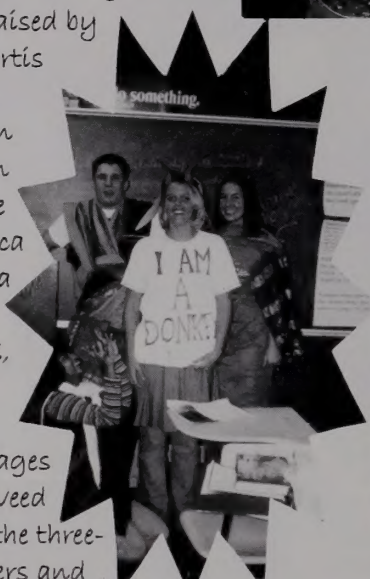

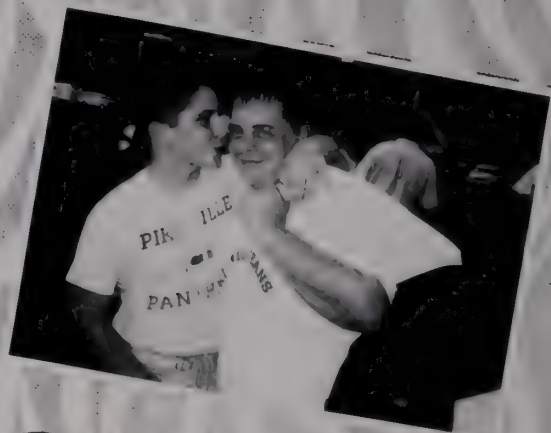

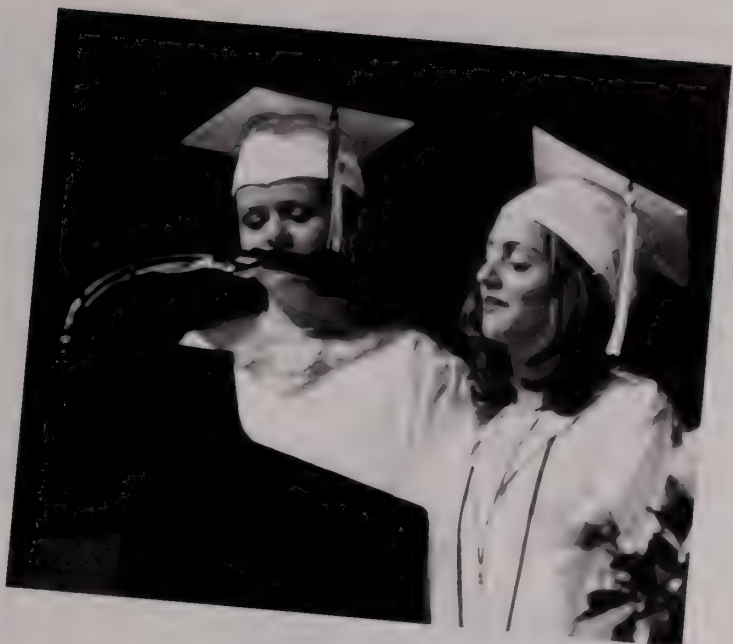

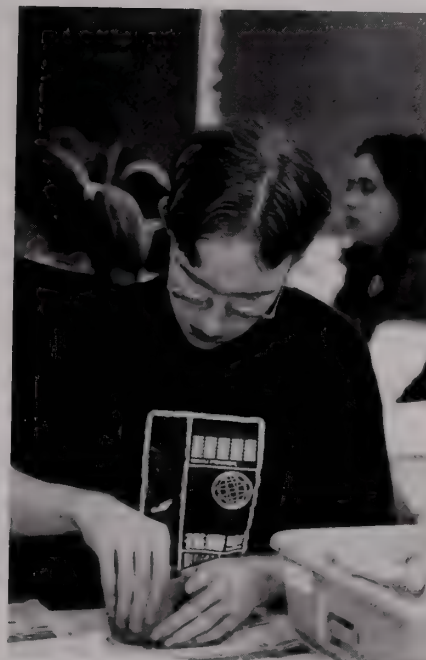

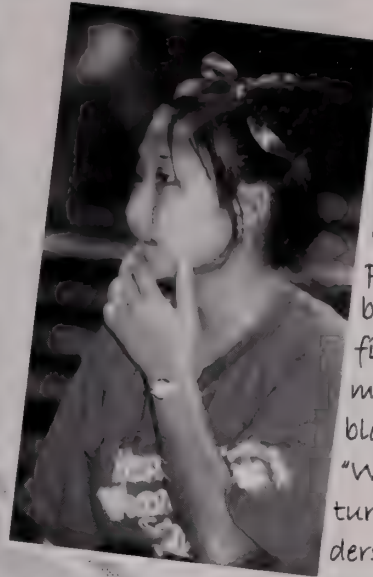

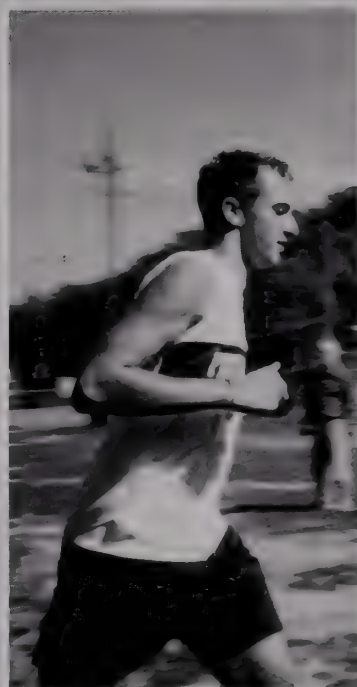

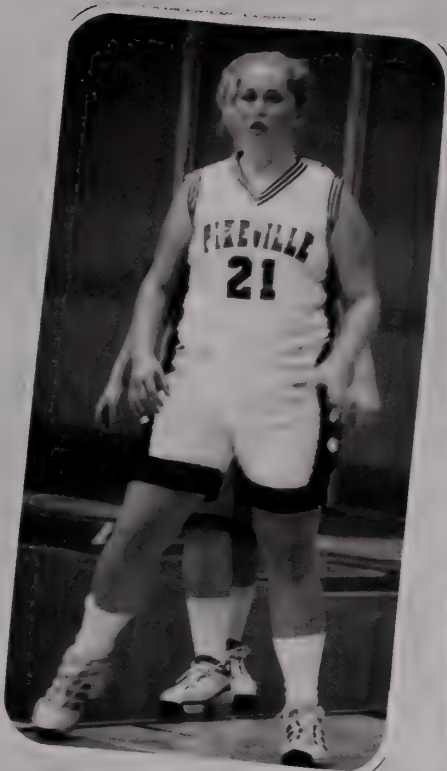

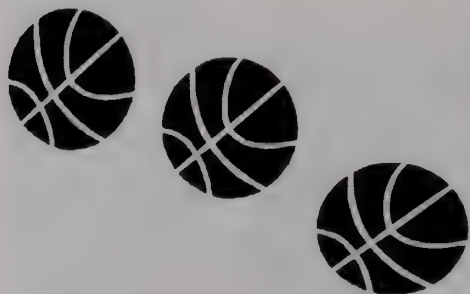

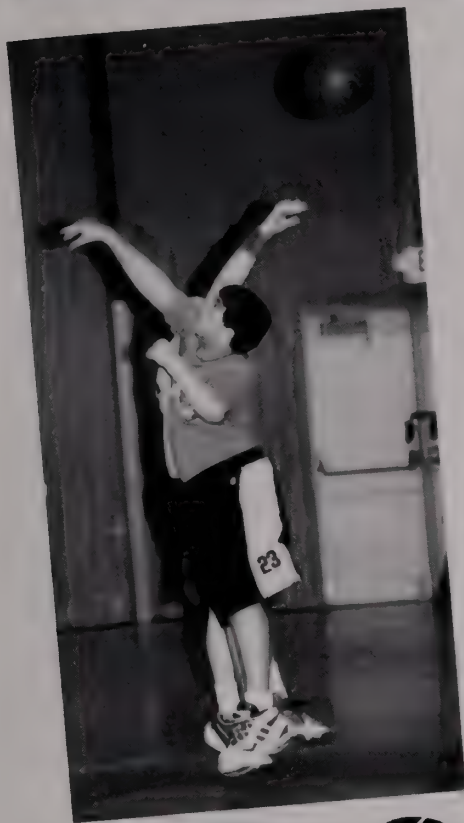
