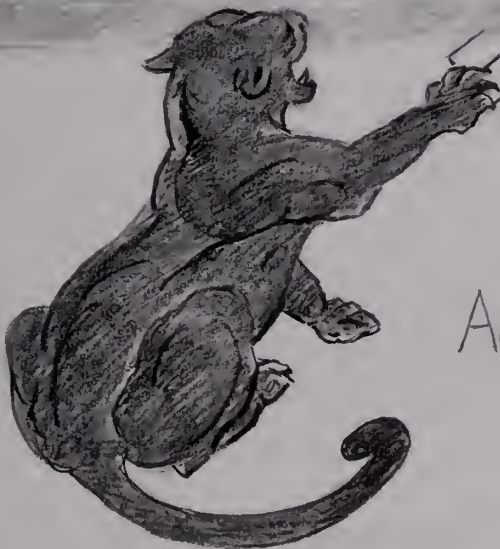

Pulse of a Panther

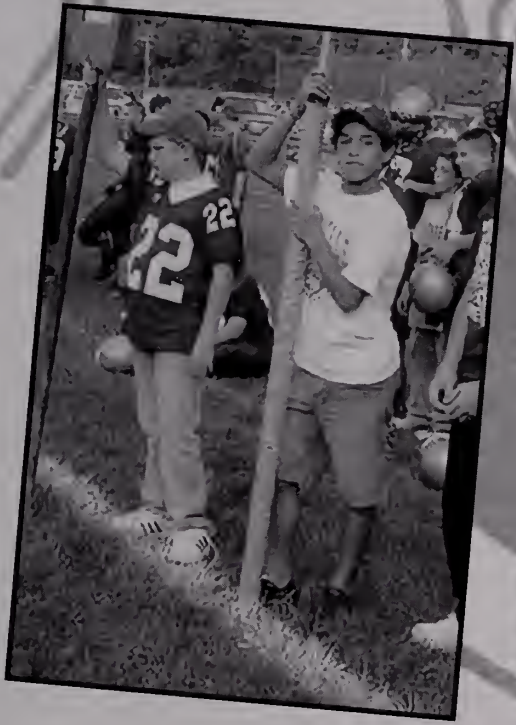

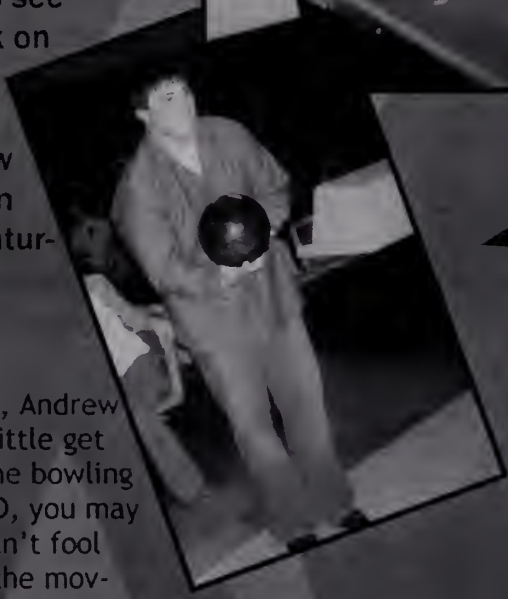

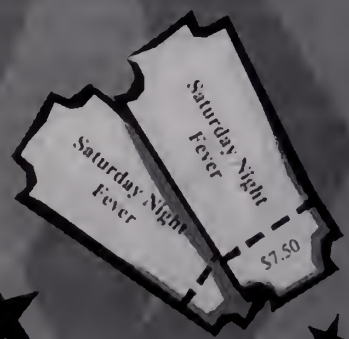


Live from Pikeville...

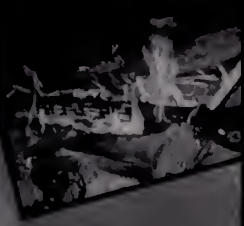

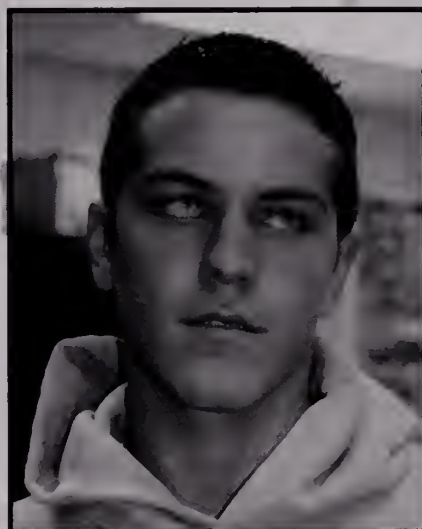

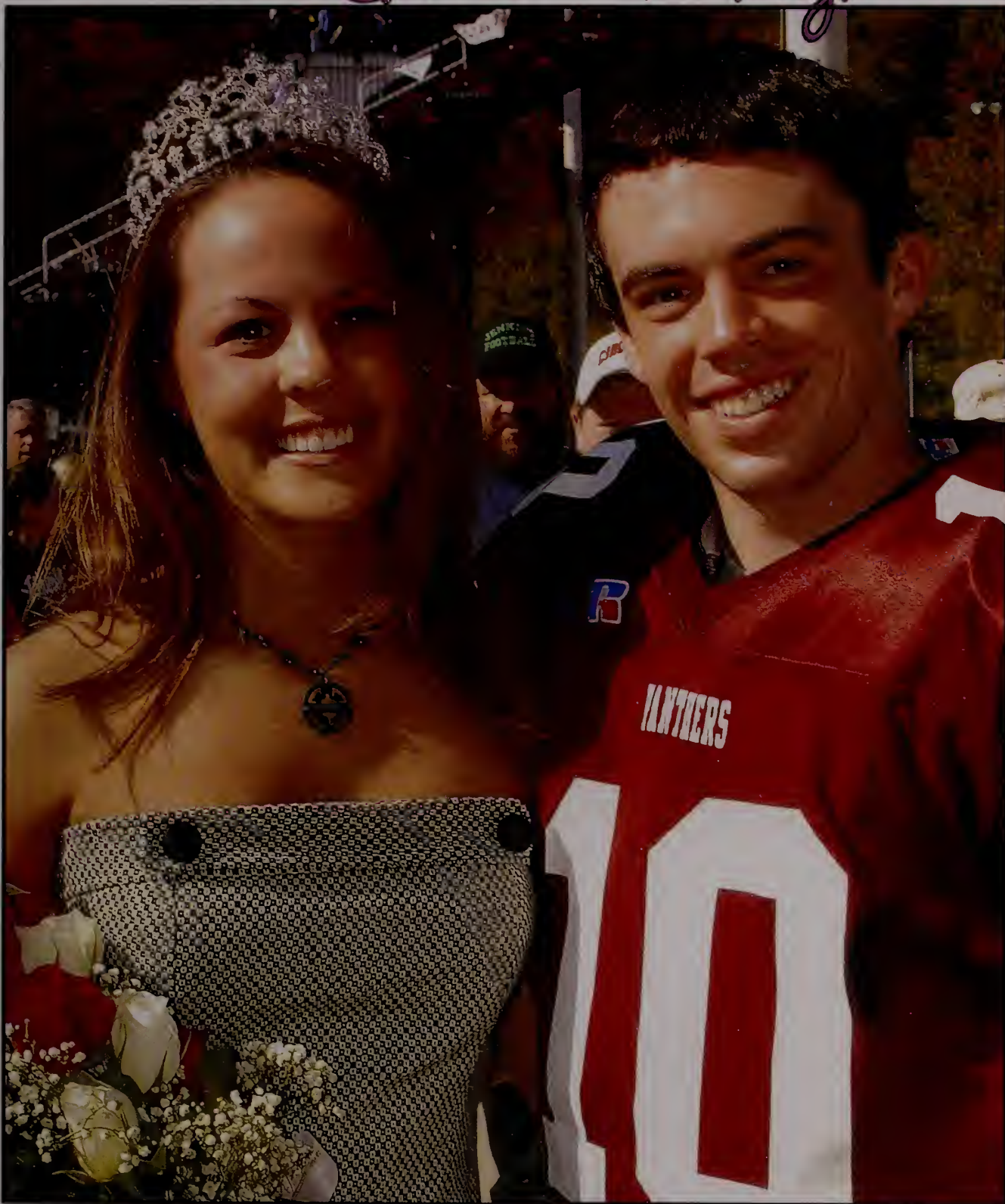

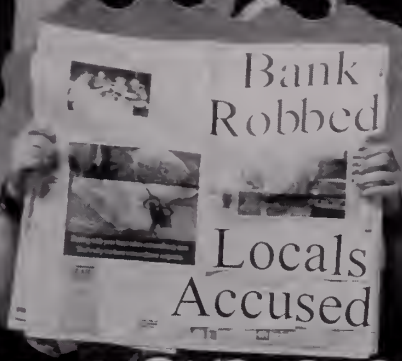

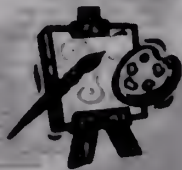
The World of Art

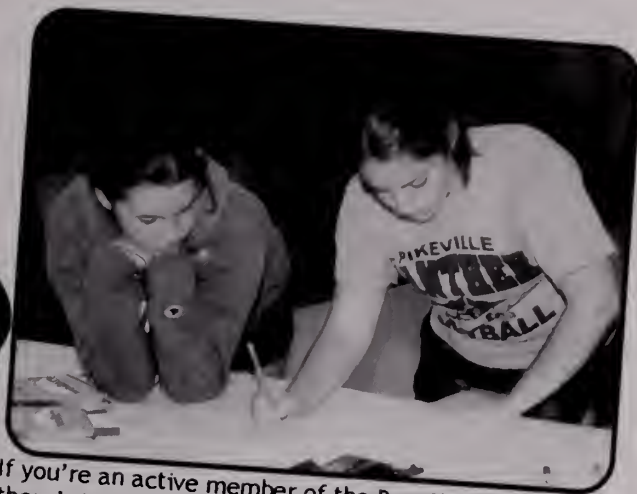

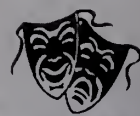

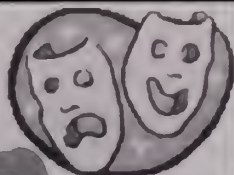

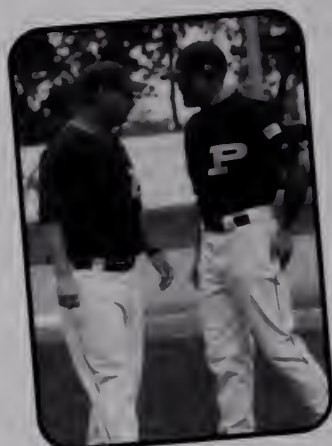

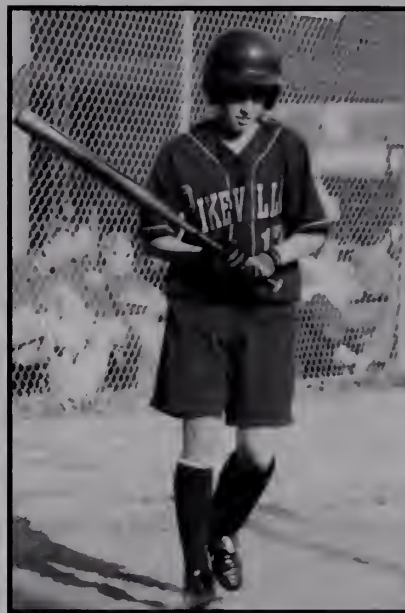

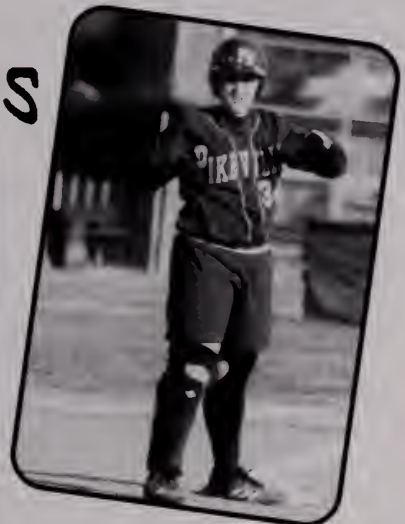
